

# How To Point My Wordpress.com Subdomain To My Hosted Account

*This article contains information about pointing your WordPress subdomain to your hosting account.*

## Domain Registration and Mapping

You can now use **your own custom domain** with your WordPress.com blog. For example, if your blog was currently at `example.wordpress.com` you could host `example.com` with us and `wordpress.com` would automatically **redirect all your links** and readers to the new domain.

How does this work? Well to get started go to **Options > Domains**. You can enter the domain you want in the box at the top.

Add a Domain:

Domain	Function	Created	Expires
<a href="#">matt.wordpress.com</a>	Your blog URL	July 20, 2005	Never

If you already have the domain registered, you can map it for \$10/yr. The next screen will tell you how to change the DNS nameservers on your domain to point to WordPress, and once you do that your domain should be live within a few hours.

This is pretty new, and somewhat technical functionality. If you have any questions at all don't hesitate to contact support using the feedback tab at the top-right of your dashboard at `wordpress.com`

Note:

If you want to use a custom theme you would also need to purchase Custom CSS from `wordpress.com`
